



Dress Code For All Angel Associates

Objective:

To present a professional appearance, while maintaining a safe environment for both employees and residents.

Badge - Must wear ID Badge as part of uniform. The associate name badge must be visible and worn above the waist at all times.

Hygiene - All associates are expected to maintain good personal hygiene without offensive odors.

Hair - Must be clean and neat and if longer than shoulder length, should be pulled back in a manner that will prevent the hair from coming in contact with the resident.

Hats - No hats/headwear are to be worn while on duty unless otherwise indicated.

Uniforms - Must fit and be worn properly.

Pants - Pants must be full length, all other dress or skirt uniforms must be within one inch above the knee or longer.

Shoes - Must wear enclosed shoes with socks or hosiery. Absolutely no exposed skin, i.e.; legs and feet. This is to prevent associate injuries.

Nails - Length of fingernails cannot exceed ½ inch beyond the tip of the finger. No attached nail decorations permitted. If artificial nails are worn, gloves must be worn during food prep and/or feeding.

Jewelry - For safety reasons, jewelry should be simple in taste, unobtrusive and compliant with each facilities policy. No dangling, gaudy or ornamental jewelry is allowed with uniforms. Other than earrings, no visible body pierced jewelry is allowed to be worn within the facilities (i.e. lips, eyebrows, tongue, nose, etc.)

Perfume - Minimal if worn, and a mild fragrance due to resident and/or co-worker allergies.

Tattoos – Those that could be taken offensively, in any way, need to be covered.

Cell Phone – Absolutely no use of your personal cell phone or clients phone, unless in the event of an extreme emergency.
